



THE RICHARD WILLIAMS SCHOLARSHIP 2026 STUDENT'S AWARD APPLICATION FORM

The Richard Williams Scholarship Fund aims to foster excellence in a chosen field by assisting a student to pursue their passion.

The Fund will award up to \$1,000 worth of goods and services to a student of Mordialloc College from any year of study in 2026 to spend on items that they need to pursue an interest.

Some examples of the items or activities for which the funds could be used include:

- Art supplies
- Musical Instrument
- Software such as drawing, movie making, communication, design apps
- Tutorials for activities such as painting/drawing, musical instrument, movie making
- Community project such as mentoring group, theatrical production, landcare/coastcare-type project, public artwork
- Electronic equipment such as camera, laptop, printer, tablet, scanner

In most cases, the Fund will negotiate the best deal on behalf of the winning applicants, and pay the supplier directly.

Alternatively, funds can be provided on a reimbursement basis, upon presentation of a receipt for purchase of the goods. Scholarship funds must be redeemed by 31 October of the year in which they are awarded, unless otherwise agreed by the RWSF board.

THIRD-PARTY NOMINATIONS

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All Richard Williams Scholarship Fund (RWSF) Student's Award applicants agree to be bound by these "Conditions of Entry".
2. All RWSF Student's Award applicants must apply by completing the "Application for Richard Williams Scholarship" form in the approved format.
3. Applications for the RWSF Student's Award are limited to those who are enrolled, or intend to enrol, in Mordialloc College for the academic year to which the award applies. Proof of enrolment must be provided to the RWSF Board upon request.
4. 'Third-Party' applications may be made on behalf of current students of Mordialloc College.
5. The RWSF Board will determine the successful RWSF Student's Award applicant from all applications received by the RWSF Board on or before 1 March each year. No applications received after this time will be considered.
6. Successful RWSF Student's Award applicants will be personally notified in April each year.
7. All decisions regarding the RWSF Student's Award are wholly at the RWSF Board's discretion and are final. No further correspondence will be entered into.
8. Each RWSF Student's Award application received will be assessed on its merits, including the following criteria:
 - (a) Academic record of the applicant;
 - (b) Level of the applicant's community involvement; and
 - (c) Financial needs of the applicant.
9. In most cases, the Fund will negotiate the best deal on behalf of the winning applicants, and pay the supplier directly. Alternatively, funds can be provided on a reimbursement basis, upon presentation of a receipt for purchase of the goods.
10. It is a condition of receiving the RWSF Student's Award that successful applicants do not use their payment for purposes other than those which it was awarded for, unless the applicant obtains the express approval of the RWSF Board.
11. The RWSF Board retains the exclusive discretion of determining what items may constitute appropriate use of the Student Award. Moneys may be recovered by the RWSF Board if it is discovered that the funds have been expended inappropriately.
12. The RWSF may require, from time to time, a progress report from the successful RWSF Student's Award applicant.
13. Scholarships must be redeemed by 31 October of the year in which they are awarded, unless otherwise agreed by the RWSF board.
